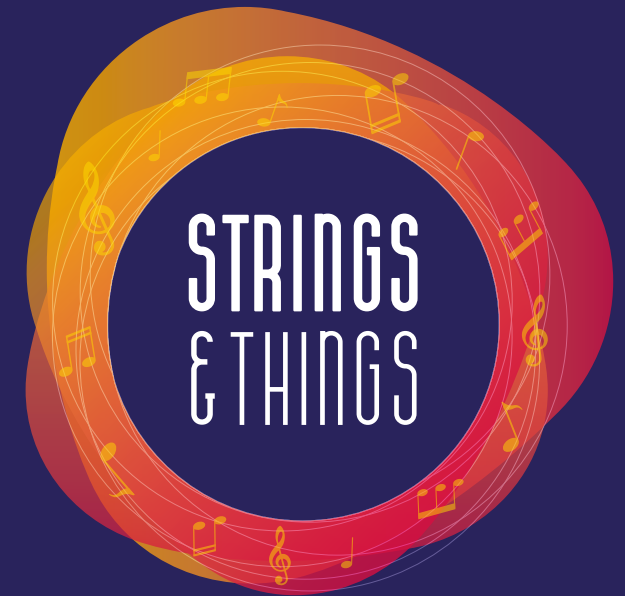


SKINNY ELVIS
